PUBLIC NOTIFICATION

MONITORING VIOLATION OF THE WATER TESTING SCHEDULE

Our water system violated a drinking water standard over the past year. Even though these were not emergencies, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we did to correct these situations.

We, The City of Mondamin Public Water Supply, are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether, or not, our drinking water meets health standards. During the third quarter of 2024 (07/01/24 - 9/30/24), the laboratory lost the samples we had submitted for testing. We did collect new samples following the incident, but by the time the samples were collected and submitted to a different lab, the required sampling period had past, resulting in a monitoring violation.

What should I do?

What Happened? What is being done?

- The Laboratory the samples were sent to, for testing, lost the samples.

-On 10/28/2024 we collected replacement Nitrite samples for the Source-Entry-Point and Distribution System, and had it tested by a DNR certified laboratory and are including the results in this notice. We hope this will help our customers feel safe and confident in the quality of our water, and show we are committed to our customers' health and well-being.

Source-Entry-Point (Water Treatment Plant)- <.05 mg/L

Distribution System (City Park, Yard Hydrant)- <.05 mg/L
